East Hanney Parish Council

Frustratingly, despite Councillor Paul Aram's and the Clerk's best efforts, the installation of fencing to secure the playing that it is vital that drains and ditches are fields in East Hanney was not an immediate success. The padlocks to secure the gate did not arrive until the day after the most recent visit from the travellers. The Council is confident that in the future the fencing will prove effective. Groups and individuals that need access to the field will be issued with the combination to the padlock and provided with regulations for access, though the Parish Council requests that people only open the gate when it is essential that they do so. You will no doubt by now be aware that another sizeable development threatens the village, with 70 or so houses and bungalows being planned for the field north of Ashfields Lane. The village has already had a 63% increase in housing, and developments such as these are never supported by the Parish Council. At a meeting on the 22nd September, the PC laid out its position and will submit the response to the Vale of White Horse DC in due course.

As the season changes, the Council reminds local residents and landowners kept clear to help any excess water flow through the village and not contribute to a flood. If you have any drains or ditches on your land, please make sure they are clear. The Hanneys Flood Group can advise if you need some assistance

The PC is working with the Arts Officer at VWHDC to replace the circular benches opposite La Fontana. The blacksmith that has been commissioned is keen to work with local groups on the final design. The Council hopes that the School and the History Group will be involved but if you are member of a group and would like to be involved, please contact the Clerk on the details below.

East Hanney Parish Council meetings are open to the public and are held on the first Wednesday of each month at 8pm. The agenda will be available to view on the notice board outside the Community Shop. on the Council's website and on Facebook a week in advance.

West Hanney Parish Council

On behalf of the Parish Council, and we are sure the whole village, we would like to welcome our new Associate Minister Revd. Alec Gill and his family. We sincerely hope they will be very happy living in West Hanney.

Many people were saddened at the loss of the Chestnut Tree in front of the Church but as this was on Parish Council land we had no choice than to have it felled. After two branches came off in only moderate strength winds we asked Tree Surgeons for a report. They condemned the tree as it had canker disease, was in a dangerous state, and advised it should be removed without delay.

One of the other Chestnuts is also showing signs of disease but should be safe for around 10 more years. Part of a Willow also came down on Headings Pond and we have arranged for this, together with the other Willows on PC land in Church Street to be pollarded.

Due to an anonymous complaint to the authorities, Sweetcroft Homes have reluctantly decided that they must ask dog walkers and ramblers not to trespass in their two fields and to keep only to the public footpaths. This is unfortunate as most villagers have no problem with the work that is being undertaken by the developers and were delighted that Sweetcroft had agreed to gift one of the fields to the village. Signs have been erected and we ask villagers to respect the decision.

White Horse DC has asked us to remind all residents that from next month no black bags must be put in, or by the side of, Green recycling bins. Clear bags only must be used so operatives can check the contents. Apparently some families are putting non-recyclable waste such as soiled nappies in their green bins, which means the whole load is contaminated and has to go to landfill.

Dear Editor.

Having read the letter from Dr Barnes in the September issue of Hanney News I feel I must correct some of his statements. Firstly, his accusation that RAF helicopters do not abide by the stringent rules that apply to low flying I consider to be unfair as all sorties are conducted following exhaustive preparation and under strict supervision. They are most certainly not aerial joyriding. It is worth remembering that it is notoriously difficult for an untrained observer to judge the height of an aircraft, and more so the larger the aircraft is, so that his estimation of a Chinook being 'at first floor height' is likely to have been inaccurate.

Secondly, Benson's helicopters are all training for operational service and that would have included the door gunner who is responsible for the self defence of the aircraft. Whilst he was no doubt practising traversing and aiming his weapon he was unlikely to be deliberately victimising Dr Barnes in his study even if he was able to see him. It is also worth noting that Puma helicopters from Benson are still currently deployed in Afghanistan so that the training they perform around the Hanneys is in earnest and the skills developed are employed daily in that country.

As to the suggestion that 'it's quite absurd having a helicopter training base in the centre of the Home Counties' is he not aware that the two busiest airports in the UK, Heathrow and Gatwick, are also located in the south east where there is a large residential population? Both airports have daily movements of aircraft that

dwarf those at Benson. The helicopters at Benson exist to support the army which is largely based in the south of England close to their main training area at Salisbury Plain so it would be impractical to move the helicopters to any of the bases he suggests, even if those airfields had the capacity to take them.

Whilst I confess that I too have been at times annoyed by the activities of the helicopters, mainly when they are operating late at night, I understand that they are conducting essential training and that this is one of the drawbacks of living in a comparatively quiet and sparsely populated part of our crowded island. I do though agree with Dr Barnes' comments regarding avaricious house builders who seem determined to concrete over all of our green spaces and I feel that they are a much worthier target for his ire than helicopters.

The Speedwatch initiative.

Probably one of the most regularly voiced concerns in our villages is the issue of speeding, and at last something is being done about it....the Speedwatch Initiative.



Volunteers, using a clever little device, see pic, with a rather natty 'eye' logo - geddit? - report speeding motorist's details to the police, who send them a warning letter. Three letters and they get a visit from the 'Roads Policing Officer', and I trust, a jolly good ticking off!



I recently spent an hour with Dick and Paul, two of the West Hanney volunteers on the Speedwatch team. We positioned ourselves on the main road in West Hanney, just west of St James school, east of Hanney Spice. The 'boys' - I use the

term loosely! - had to wear hi-viz vests. Once the kit had been set up, we waited for motorists who clearly had no regard for the speed limit, or, more importantly, the

safety of their fellow citizens. Most who passed are well within the 30mph limit - I suspect some alerted by the hi-viz gear - but



a few apparently couldn't care less. We clocked one idiot at 44mph. After a while a large lorry parked opposite us, delivering building materials to a nearby house and hence reducing the road to a narrow single lane. That didn't bother one chap...he still barrelled through at 37mph. The details of these two, and 3 others, were passed onto the police.

If you could spare an hour once in a while to help with this very worthy project. please contact Gerald Chaffey on 868627 who leads the West Hanney crew. Meanwhile East Hanney have their own team, and they've done some statistical analysis which reveals that, over a 13 day period, they monitored approx, 3,000 vehicles. 306 exceeded the speed limit, at an average speed of 38.8 mph, with one reaching 47 mph past the school and another driving at 70mph on the A338 in the 30mph limit. They too need volunteers, so please contact Guy Langton if you can help. Page 6 for his contact details. Speedwatch won't solve the problem, but it's a step in the right direction, and the teams of volunteers deserve our thanks.
