


Hey everyone, did you

East Hanney Parish Council

Your local Neighbourhood Action Group (NAG) is seeking new members. With regret, I inform you that without volunteers your area stands to lose the Faringdon East Neighbourhood Action Group. It requires volunteers for the positions of both Chair and Secretary.

If you have the time to commit to four meetings a year leading a group of people from across the area to support the police defining and dealing with neighbourhood priorities then please contact Robert.maris@thamesvalley.pnn.police.uk. Regrettably there are no further meetings of the group scheduled whilst these positions remain vacant. The only foreseeable option would be to seek permission from the Faringdon West Action Group to amalgamate with them. As well as being an important community forum with the police, the group has been pivotal in obtaining "Smartwater Village" status for 3 villages, reducing burglaries in the areas and for the Speedwatch initiative providing important data to target police enforcement activity.

If being a Parish Councillor is more to your taste, then it will be of interest to you to know that the next elections are in about a year – in May 2019. At this election, East Hanney Parish Council will be expanding to 8 members. If you are interested in the village and its community, and would like to be instrumental in helping to shape its future, please consider standing. To find out more, please contact the Clerk by email or telephone. Unlike other parts of the county, we're not having an election on 3 May 2018, so don't expect any voting cards or postal votes.

Finally, if you have an allotment in East Hanney, please remember to pass you annual rental to Jim Triffitt as soon as possible.

Parish Council meetings are open to the public and are held on the first Wednesday of each month at 8pm. The agenda will be available on the notice board outside the Community Shop, on the Council's website and on Facebook a week in advance. In May the Council meeting will be preceded by the Council's AGM and later in May the Annual Parish Meeting will be held. If you have any items that wish to be discussed at this meeting (any East Hanney registered elector can put an item on the agenda and speak), please contact the Clerk by the end of April 2018.

West Hanney Parish Council

At the time of writing we are still awaiting the planning department's decision on the application for 35 houses off School Road. The delay is apparently due to Oxfordshire County Council's continuing failure to respond to the Planning Department's enquiries. The road to Denchworth had to be closed for a day early in April when persistent rainfall caused a flood. Several cars ignored the signs which was probably an expensive mistake as they had to be recovered by breakdown services.

Your Councillors are still looking for someone to join them as Parish Clerk. This is a vitally important and interesting role and a small salary is payable. If you are at all interested in joining the team, please ring Kay Sayers for an informal chat.

The Annual Parish Accounts are now available for anyone who wishes to view them. Please either come along to our next meeting or again call Kay Sayers to arrange a mutually convenient time. The Accounts will also appear on our website in due course and will be posted on the Parish Notice Board adjacent to the Bus Shelter.

Staff operating on behalf of the Vale were scheduled to be in the village to carry out a deep clean on areas we had specified as needing attention. We are grateful to the Vale for this operation, which together with the annual litter pick organised by Bob Wilson should

mean neat and tidy streets for a while. Several people have asked why they have not yet received voting papers for the local elections, but unlike other parts of the country there are no elections in this area this year. The next scheduled elections in the South Oxfordshire and Vale of White Horse districts are in May 2019.

Another working party was held recently in the Community Woodland which will be the last until Autumn. Paul Savers reports that fifteen volunteers turned up and carried out more cutting back to prevent encroachment on the sides of the rides, and a magnificent haul of some 7 large skip bags of tree guards were gathered. This collection saves the guards from breaking up and blowing around in the wind. More open areas were created as a result, which will benefit wild flowers and butterflies. Many thanks to all who helped, and to Kay Sayers for the usual scrummy cakes and liquid refreshments.

Since the working party there has been a lot of rain and parts of the Woodland became very muddy with standing water in places making walking around rather difficult and unpleasant. Just the English Countryside in winter I'm afraid. Hopefully it has all dried up by now.

Our advertising rates are competitive; we always

Spring is a good time for a Spring Clean....

especially in the ditches, streams and culverts around our villages which we all rely on to minimise flood risk. They need to be respected, protected and improved, and now's a good time to do a spring clean of your watercourses because much of the vegetation has died back over winter and new growth has not yet started. Many people believe "The Council" are responsible for the ditches around the village - this is not so. If you own land (houses) adjoining, above or with a watercourse running through it, you have certain responsibilities. In legal terms you are the "Riparian Owner". If your land boundary is next to a watercourse it is assumed you own the land up to the centre of the watercourse. Riparian owners are responsible for the maintenance of any watercourse that runs alongside or through their property.

Himalayan balsam is a major weed problem, especially on riverbanks and waste land, but can also invade gardens. It grows rapidly and spreads quickly, smothering other vegetation as it goes. It tolerates low light levels and also shades out other vegetation, so gradually impoverishes habitats by killing off other plants. Once established near a



waterway the seeds, which can remain viable for two years, are spread further afield by the water.

For the past 3 or 4 years members of the Hanney Flood Group have been striving to remove this invasive plant from the banks of Letcombe Brook. We regularly organise small working parties to clear the weed.

The main method of control, and frankly the most effective, is pulling up the complete plants before they flower and set seed.

If you have Himalayan balsam growing on the land you are responsible for as Riparian owners, adjacent to Letcombe Brook, Childrey Brook or any other water course around the village please help us to eliminate this very invasive plant.




