plant the trees, with special thanks going to the Friends of St James School for providing much needed sustenance and refreshments after our exertions.


I didn't think we would actually run out of trees, as the planters really seemed

### **West Hanney Parish Council**

#### **Highways Issues**

We are still waiting for information on the timing of the remedial work for the drainage system repairs around Church Street. Until this is completed we will still see flooding in this section of road.

#### **Finances**

Many of you will have noticed an increase in the Parish Council precept. In January the Parish Council agreed to raise sufficient funds from the precept, now set at £12,000, to enable

us to properly maintain our community assets and to ensure that we have sufficient reserves. For example in 2019 we invested in our three speed monitors which have been very effective in developing speed awareness for the road users in our village and providing very valuable data for further work. This purchase depleted our small reserve. In 2020 we have some significant expenditures including the replacement of fencing around our extended community woodland, the improved parking outside the church and, following a professional survey of the trees along school road and others that we are responsible for, some significant maintenance costs to ensure that they remain safe.

#### **Wayleaves**

A wayleave is a payment from the electricity company that has equipment on land it does not own, to the land owner. The Parish Council has been working with the electricity company to make sure that



all of the equipment, be it substations or poles, on Parish land is correctly identified and that the wayleaves are in place. This provides an additional income to the Parish

#### Pot Holes - We have a volunteer 'Fix My Street Super User'

As I mentioned last month the County Council Highways Department has set up a program of 'Fix My Street Super Users' whereby each Parish Council can report road damage directly to the County Council's contractors who will then fix it. A volunteer has come forward to take on this role which is excellent news.


