Last month I was pleased to feature the

story of Mandy Brewerton who by the time you read this, will have jumped out of an aeroplane to raise money for charity!

This month I want to tell you about Caroline Watson, a West Hanney resident who is also attempting to raise funds for charity, this time by cycling rather a long way. Here's what she told me.... 'I'm cycling 500km from London to Paris over 4 days

in early June to raise as much money as I can for the charity, 'Cure Leukaemia', which helps blood cancer patients access pioneering drug and transplant treatments by funding specialist research nurses across the UK to trial and develop new and potentially lifesaving treatments. I'm riding with a group of local friends from Steventon and Cholsey.

Cure Leukaemia is a cause near to our

hearts as we've a close friend whose young son is currently going through the disease.



We want to do what we can to support them, their family and others diagnosed with blood cancer.
We all also love a challenge!

As a novice road cyclist, it's a really daunting challenge for me (not least because there are many more very big hills between London and Paris than I realised when I signed up!). It's been tough to fit in the training

miles, alongside work and family life but I can't wait to get started on the road to Paris in a few weeks' time.

Every pound I raise goes straight to Cure Leukaemia, helps save lives and hastens global progress to eradicate blood cancer. I would be enormously grateful if any Hanney News readers could spare a few pennies in support.

They certainly do and will try to influence decisions in those areas. And just to mention that as well as being our District Councillor, Sally Povolotsky is a County Councillor for the Hendreds and Harwell, having been elected back in May 2021, so she'll be very familiar with the workings of the County.



The charity works closely with 11 NHS paediatric retrieval teams across the UK, enabling them to bring their specialist equipment on board to safely transfer their patients.

If a child is too sick to fly, we can fly a specialist team directly to them.

We receive no government or National Lottery funding and rely on donations to raise the £3,500 needed for every mission. In 2023 the charity introduced England's first incubator on a rotary-wing aircraft and this year is celebrating its



10th anniversary of providing lifesaving high-speed transfers for critically ill babies and children. THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND



In front of me was a wall of Bibles. I needed to buy two as gifts for young people who were going to be confirmed. There was a lot of choice. Which ones to choose?

Over the years I have been given Bibles to mark attending Sunday School, getting baptised, being confirmed and becoming a vicar. I have bought different types of Bibles; to help me study, to carry around with me and with bigger print, so I can read more comfortably.

For me the Bible is both a library and a toolbox.

It is a collection of different writing that has helped me learn about the relationship between God and humanity through the Hebrew Scriptures, the Old Testament, and the life of Jesus and the early church, in the New Testament. It contains historic narratives, biography's, letters, songs, building instructions, laws, poetry (some a bit saucy), reflections on life and lots of long lists of names. Exploring in different ways what in means to be flourish as a human created by God and the ways that we can find meaning and purpose in life.

Like a toolbox, the Bible allowed me to engage with God and shape my life. I use it to examine my motivation, dissected my thoughts, cut into knotty problems, carve out rhythms of life, work on relationships and navigate different seasons of life. Getting to grips with the Bible, is an on-going process that takes time, effort and the help of others to learn the skills and understanding needed to handle it well. Like a hammer, the Bible is ancient but still very useful. Also, like a hammer, if used incorrectly, it can hurt rather than help others.

I ended up buying two study Bibles, with extra notes and relevant information in them, as gifts for the two people getting confirmed. Hopefully, these Bibles will guide them through the different writing styles and help them dig deeper into their relationship with God.

ing rain on Saturday - well not him personally obviously...umbrellas aplenty on offer when you're the monarch! - whilst we on the other hand enjoyed a glorious sunny Sunday, even to the point that elderly gentleman reached for their union jack bedecked hats, not just for patriotic reasons, but also to protect balding pates from the rays!

There were many Duck races superbly organised and run by Sir Paul of Aram and slightly too short Wellys, with help from his missus Lisa, that were interrupted at one point by a swan making its way along the brook which had become - temporarily - a duck race track.

A cake stall selling the most delicious fayre run by the Friends of St James School, bouncy castles, the usual array of play equipment, recently installed and much used, all added to the day's merriment as did an array of gastronomic delights spread across and weighing down every table. Massive thanks must go to the organising committee - Rosie Reed, Hilary Cakebread Hall, Graham Garner, David and Jenny Corps and Adrian Bodimeade - who all did such a fab job. They worked tirelessly before the event, throughout the afternoon, and afterwards tidying up!

This month's calendar pic

is one of my favourites. Taken in - I would guess - about 1910, it shows the beautiful house 'Castleacre', which still looks magnificent today on the village green in West Hanney at the southern end of Winter Lane. It's Grade II listed, maybe built around 1600, and is one of the oldest in all Hanney. It's also one of the few pure limestone houses

in the village and has a magnificent slate roof....probably Stonesfield.

The gable windows on the roof elevation that faces Winter Lane have been changed but it is largely original. In the recently produced 'West Hanney Character Assessment' it is rightly described as a 'memorable building'.

As well as its obvious charms making the photograph so attractive, I love the children all lined up in the photo, the five slightly older boys separated from the girls and the younger boys with their nannies or maybe teachers? No one in the pic stands close to anyone else, it's all very formally posed. I assume the children had been brought out from nearby St James School for the pic?

On the far left stands a gent with a small white dog. Perhaps he just happened to be out walking his pet, came upon the scene, and was asked to pose with the children, though well away from them.

I think the photographer was Henry Taunt, who also took the photos of the Buttercross in West Hanney when it was dedicated by the Bishop of Oxford in 1908 - see my booklet 'The West Hanney Buttercross'. (He was a most interesting chap and well worth researching.)

Beyond Castleacre the photograph shows a quite large property that no longer exists. For some time it was owned by Billy Hill and his family. They were originally from



London and ran a bicycle repair workshop from the house. Billy was a very accomplished racing cyclist who could cycle from his home to Oxford in 25 minutes...quite an achievement given the bicycles of the time. Billy's dedication... well obsession really ...meant that as an older man he was very disabled. He died aged about 69 in 1945. Billy had a brother called Tom, 6 years older, who was a horse racing tipster, and another called Alfred, 3 years younger. He was a painter and decorator and worked for local builders IP Barrett. He used to swear a lot I'm assured by those who knew him, and suffered with his prostate! Maybe the two were connected? The Hill boys had a sister called Emma, born in 1875. Also a resident for a time in the Hill family home was one Esme Lucy Amy Alcock who was a private teacher. She may have been a relative of the Hill family, but was much younger than the boys, having been born in 1908. She moved to Woodpecker Cottage further up Winter Lane when it was built, probably in the mid 1950s. She set up a little private school, and rumour has it that there are folk still in the village who attended. If you're one, let me know. Esme lived to be 99, allegedly, but had moved to pastures new some time before her death in 2007. Big thanks to my 'boys', John Spindloe, Terry Flynn and Frank Bunce for sharing their memories.




