'Breaking news' as I write this, but rather old hat as you read it. I'm afraid Acorn Bioenergy, the company based in London who were hoping to build an 'anaerobic digester' between Grove and West Hanney, recently withdrew their application just before the Vale of White Horse District Council Planning Committee were due to decide on the plans. Apparently, the company is now 'reviewing its options'.

Had the plans gone to the Vale for approval, they may have struggled to win much favour. The Vale's planning officer Adrian

Butler had already recommended they were refused, and hundreds of objections had been received. The four local parish councils – Grove, Charney Bassett, East Hanney and West Hanney, as well as Wantage Town Council and Oxfordshire County Council all chipped in with their twopenny worths - all opposing. At a lively and packed Parish Council meeting a while back, which I attended, the vast majority of the many folk there were against, with only a couple of voices for it, keen to stress the 'Green' advantages. Few seemed convinced.

# THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND

**Dear Friends** 

I attended St Mary's convent last month and the room I stayed in was named Janani Luwum. He was Archbishop of the Church of Uganda, arrested for speaking against the government in February 1977 and died shortly after. Although the official account

describes a car crash, it is generally accepted that he was murdered on the orders of then President Idi Amin, since his body was riddled with bullet wounds. 1977 was the year I started my theological training at St John's Nottingham

where Janani had also studied in the previous year.

It may not be a very pleasant thought to consider martyrs, but it certainly makes me extremely grateful that we can worship freely and, if we consider it necessary, to protest without fear against immoral and dubious practices by the powers that be. Another such martyr was St James, fisherman, the son of the Zebedee and brother to John. Jesus called him to leave his father and fishing and follow him as his disciple. For 3 years he travelled around the country with Jesus and was often only one of 3 friends to accompany Jesus at special occasions. He was a witness to the crucifixion and saw the resurrected Jesus courageously telling others about Jesus until King Herod had James beheaded. St James is well known around our parishes; West Hanney is dedicated to St James the Great as was the old church of Grove; and the school in Hannev is called

St James too. The old church in East Hanney was dedicated to James the less (the brother of Jesus).

I even found one website that said the church at East Challow used to be called St James; but I don't consider it to be reliable. At St James, Denchworth it is a little unclear as to which James is referred to, but I like to think it is James the Great whose festival falls this month on 25<sup>th</sup> July. At Hanney we will be celebrating this on July 16<sup>th</sup> before schools break up; in

Denchworth on 23rdJuly, when the Bishop of Dorchester is coming to preach at our 6pm Evensong led by a festival choir. Both should be great occasions. Remembering such people as James and Janani who remained

true to their faith even to the point of martyrdom makes me wonder if I would have the courage to stand firm like them in face of persecution, but more positively causes me to be truly thankful that we can openly and freely profess our faith in Jesus Christ.

St James' symbol is the scallop shell.

One later story recounts that after James was martyred in Jerusalem in the year 44, his body was taken to Spain and when the ship reached the shore



a horse was spooked and fell in the water. The story goes on to say how both the horse and rider were miraculously saved and came forth from the water covered in scallop shells.

God bless - John



#### **Our local MP David Johnston**

recently held a survey of our views on health services survey. Perhaps you were one of the 2,838 people who responded? A summary of the results reveals that 77% of those that took part said they had had difficulty getting a GP appointment in the last year.

44% said they had had difficulty accessing an appointment with a dentist.

Unsurprisingly, 97% felt we do not have enough GPs and 98% felt we do not have enough dentists.

David goes on to say in his latest newsletter... "I completely agree and have been banging the drum on our health services since I was elected. Not long after the survey closed, I secured a debate in parliament about our health services and intend to keep banging heads together until we get the services we need."

Well David, whatever you bang, whether it's drums or heads, we wish you every success in your efforts. We certainly need a massive improvement over the existing situation!

Pat was well known to many of the villagers having moved here from Oxford in 1972. She was an active member of village life – flower arranging at St James church for many years, volunteering at Hanney playgroup where her two daughters Jo & Kate attended.

An enthusiastic member of

Hanney WI, she really enjoyed going to listen to the speakers and could recount in detail what had been said.

When she was at her peak fitness she would regularly be on the Hanney tennis courts enthusiastically swinging her racket around, whilst at the same time shouting "Oh darn it". She had to retire her game when there were more exclamations of disappointment than winning shots which frustrated her greatly.

The Gardening club was a particular favourite as this was her enduring passion, and was so proud of her garden. She had a ruthless approach – the plants had two choices – delight me or get dug up! She always looked forward to helping at the annual plant sale with her beloved sister, who had the knack for cuttings and the patience for growing from seed, something which she lacked.

Pat loved to help at the Tuesday Coffee Morning Club at the village hall - manning the tea & coffee urn - her organizational skills were always admired by everyone, especially by us as a family. She was the only one who knew what was going on when and where.

Whilst Mum had many creative talents; flower arranging, knitting, crocheting &



cooking, she probably dreaded the eponymous Hanney pantomime the most, as her girls were in Nancy Becker's ballet class & it meant she had to dust off her sewing machine and fire up her creative skills to make the costumes. Fancy dress competitions on Hanney Fete Day was also a challenging time. Yet she always excelled herself at inventive, sometimes bizarre outfits, that baffled her girls who were often

too shy to wear them.

In her later years Pat attended St James Church on Sundays, whenever she hadn't overdone it in the garden the day before. She enjoyed a good sing-song, catching up with villagers & having a coffee & chat after the service.

The Plough has been a constant favourite, especially now Owain has taken it over. At least once a week Pat & Tony could be found on the locals' corner table talking to everyone AND anyone. Pat used to walk daily around the village to stay active. In the past she took up Tap, Keep Fit, Jazz Dance & Tai Chi until her brain found it hard to co-ordinate with her feet. Friday film club at the village hall, Pat would attend with friends or neighbours, for a good social start to the weekend.

Pat will be greatly missed by many – she had an open door policy - neighbours and friends would pop in and receive a warm welcome. She always had something prepared to offer her guests, whether it was a hearty casserole or just nibbles, fine wine and good company. She wouldn't want people to cry over her but rather put on a big smile & raise a glass of something to her memory & celebrate her full life.


