"As featured in July Hanney News, tenants Owain and Luke recently celebrated a magnificent first year at the helm of The Plough, collecting a haul of prestigious and well-deserved awards along the way.

From what I'm hearing at Global

HQ, our 20mph speed



limit is not universally popular!
On the grapevine the word is that the change in average speeds since its introduction is minimal. No matter, the policy continues to be rolled out across the county.... Marcham, Kennington and Standlake are just three of the latest bunch of thirteen areas to join the scheme.

Meantime, the Fire Brigade have chipped in with this observation on the limit being imposed in Wantage....

"Wantage fire station is served by on-call staff that must live within 5 minutes. At 30mph, that's 2.5 miles away. Under a 20mph zone, this drops to 1.67 miles. The recruitment area would drop to 44.6% of its current size. This would, in all likelihood cause the Wantage fire station to close. Wantage, Grove and surrounding villages would then need to be served by crews from Abingdon and Didcot stations. The potential increase in deaths due to the increased response times would be a direct result of the implementation of the 20mph zones in Wantage." I'd not heard this argument before...a bit of an over-reaction perhaps, but maybe not?

Three new benches will also appear around the village, one being in Holmes' Garden. The railings around Holmes' Garden are receiving a fresh lick of paint to complete the renovation.

the playground should be completed this month.

A plan, with the help of the home owner, has been put forward to Highways to increase the width of the footpath as it approaches the school from the Memorial Hall, making it easier for those with pushchairs and especially double buggies.

By October, we will be down to only four of us at home. Our two eldest children will at university, one starting and the other returning for their 2nd year. As we prepare to send them off, I have spoken to them about this being a particularly difficult period of emotional readjustment, for me let alone them!

Seeing my children heading off on their own journey into adult life, is making me nostalgic for their childhood, causing me to reflect on my relationship with them, as well as thinking over my own childhood/adult relationship with my parents and my own experiences of university.

Parenthood is about supporting children to grow from being dependent on their parents, to becoming increasing independent; I now no longer need to wash them, feed them or carry them around everywhere. Yet, this is not the end point in parenting or adult life. The goal is not to just be independent, as we all need the help and support others. What we should be aiming for is interdependence. As adults,

we can both support others, while they support us. This recognises the complex interactions between the different people in our lives.

In Ephesians Chapter 6 children are instructed to honour their parents; a great Bible verse!

But wait, then parents are told, not to frustrate or provoke their children. The parent-child relationship is meant to be a two-way supportive relationship. I won't always get this right, but hopefully I will find ways to help my children step out on their own, while also giving them appropriate help and guidance. I am going to miss them and worry a lot about how they are doing, but I am also focusing on looking forward to entering a new chapter of my relationship with them as independent and interdependent adults. But I am not looking forward to all the dirty washing they will bring home at Christmas!

Anyone who has walked through St James churchyard this summer will have marvelled at the wonderful display of wild flowers - with mown paths making access around the front of the church, to the Ashes Memorial Area and across the old part of the rear churchyard, easy.

The area to the southeast where current graves are situated will continue to be mown more regularly.

To maintain the churchyard at its best the area will be managed to create a bee (and other insect) friendly area and be environmentally responsible.

And still on a green theme...

apparently our prickly little friend the hedgehog is in rapid decline across Europe, and especially here in the UK. Part of the problem is lack of holes or gaps in our garden fencing, meaning isolated hedgehog populations. In order to find food, water, mates and nesting sites,

Sadly, an unknown person has recently sprayed a heavy concentration of weedkiller along the front path, which does not accord with how we plan to manage the area.

Although parts of Hanney parish land were also sprayed we have checked with the Parish Council and this was not done either at their behest or with their permission. We would therefore politely request that this. however well intentioned, action, is not repeated in the churchyard. Yours,

This month's photo from our calendar is of the house in East Hanney named 'Hazelwood', more or less opposite the Black Horse pub on Main St. See current photo far right, which shows the same gable end of the property.

It has much history attached to it and I'm very grateful to the current owners John and Georgie Newman, who gave me much of the following info.

The original part of the house (two separate cottages to the rear) was built around 1700. The front of the house was built by IR Holmes, one of Hanney's more well known and quite controversial characters, who owned the property in addition to his main residence - The Mulberries - at the end of the 19th Century. He used the outbuildings at Hazelwood for his "mail order" business - selling condoms basically - regularly cycling from our house to the post office. which I think at the time would have been at Shepherds Cottage next door to St James the Less church further along Main St. IR was, unlike his US counterpart from 'Dallas' - only more mature folk with a refined taste in TV drama will remember him - a generally rather philanthropic chap and he allowed the Dandridge family to reside at Hazelwood when they fell on hard times. The property was originally named "Buddleias" up until the war years. At the outbreak of the Second World War

the house was owned by a Mrs Flynn. She put up a number of London teachers - see photo - Mrs Walker, Christian Stone, Chrissie Atkinson, Mabel Masters and Doris Smith and their dogs - who came down from London along with a large number of evacuee





children.

At some point between then and now, the name of the house was changed to its current one... 'Hazelwood'.

Now the frustrating bit. The photo isn't very clear, but if you look closely in the bottom right hand corner - you may need to be looking at the full size calendar* pic to see this - there are several children posing rather formally - I suspect as instructed by the photographer - in front of the fence and gate to the house.

They are all well dressed with the 3 boys wearing large caps, sat on the ground. Behind them and to their left are two small girls, then a smallish dog, then two bigger girls, a small girl and another bigger girl. The small one is holding hands with both the bigger ones standing either side of her. Standing on her own, and looking to be the youngest child of them all, stands another small girl. Who are these children? I would guess the photo was taken before the First World War, but after the turn of the century. At the time the house was used as good ole' JR's office, so the children almost certainly did not live there. Any ideas?






